Present petition has been filed under Section 482 CrPC for issuance of direction to respondent Nos.1 to 3 to provide protection of life, liberty and property of the petitioner and further direction to respondent Nos.1 to 3 to arrest the private respondents and take action in FIR No.104 dated 26.09.2016, under Sections 307, 324, 323, 506, 148, 149 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on) at Police Station Bahaw Wala, District Fazilka.

None had appeared on behalf of the petitioner on 06.09.2019 and 01.04.2022. The position remains the same even today, despite the case having been called thrice.

Learned State counsel submits that the main grouse in the petition was that the accused are roaming freely and have not been arrested, thus, protection was being sought. In this regard, he makes a reference to para 5 of the status report dated 10.12.2019 by way of affidavit of Sandeep Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, (Rural) Abohar, District Fazilka to submit that all the accused have been arrested except one, who has been declared PO. He on

instructions further submits that the trial stands committed to the Court of Sessions.

In view of the aforesaid, no further orders are required to be passed.

Petition is dismissed.
