1. Instant revision petition has been filed under Section 401 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking setting aside the judgment of conviction and order of sentence dated 12.03.2013 passed by learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gurdaspur and judgment dated 22.05.2014 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Gurdaspur.
2. There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.
3. Same was the position on the previous two occasions.
4. As per office report, counsel representing the petitioner has been informed by e-mail, but still there is no appearance on behalf the petitioner.
5. State counsel has filed Custody Certificate dated 17.07.2023, which is taken on record.
6. As per the Custody Certificate, sentence awarded in the case has been completed by the convict on 06.02.2021. It seems that the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the matter.
