Affidavit dated 06.01.2023 of Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazilka has been filed in Court. The same is taken on record. A copy thereof has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

Based upon the aforementioned affidavit, learned State counsel submits that the petitioner has executed affidavit dated 19.09.2022 stating that the apprehension of threat is no longer in existence. A copy of this affidavit is on record as Annexure R-2/T.

A perusal of the aforementioned affidavit reveals that the dispute arose on account of an agreement to sell executed in favour of Sukhpal Singh. The said agreement has now fructified into a registered sale deed and the entire consideration has been received. Thus, the dispute has come to an end.

In view of the aforementioned, affidavit it is evident that the petition has been rendered infructuous. It is disposed of as such with liberty to the petitioner to revive the same, in case, cause of action survives.
