The petitioner herein has sought the relief of anticipatory bail in the criminal case arisen out of the FIR bearing No.64 dated 11.04.2022 as registered at Police Station City Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran, under Sections 406, 498-A and 506 IPC.

2. Learned State counsel, on the instructions from ASI Sukha Singh from the above-referred Police Station, informs the Court that in compliance of the orders passed by the Co-ordinate Benches on 31.10.2022, 14.03.2023, 03.05.2023 and this Court on 10.07.2023, the petitioner has joined in the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required and he is also not involved in any other criminal case.

3. In view of the afore-discussed submission as made by learned State counsel, the present petition is allowed and the relief of interim bail, as extended to petitioner-Sumeet Singh @ Sehmi by the Co-ordinate Bench vide the said order dated 31.10.2022, is hereby made absolute.

4. However, the petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when required/called upon to do so and shall also strictly abide by all the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
