By way of present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 to 4 to proceed against the private respondents, who have inflicted injuries upon the son of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in an incident dated 14.01.2023, private respondents gave beatings to the son of the petitioner with sharp edged weapons and MLR dated 14.01.2023 was also prepared in this regard.

Referring to the representation dated 15.01.2023 (Annexure P-2 at page 19 of the paper book), learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite the incident having been brought to the notice of official respondents, no action has been taken by them against the private respondents.

Upon advance notice, Mr. Tarun Aggarwal, Sr. DAG, Punjab, on instructions from ASI Durlabh Darshan, Police Station Jandiala, submits

that so far MLR has not been received in the police station concerned, thereby, causing delay in proceeding against the private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that copy of MLR dated 14.01.2023 shall be presented to the SHO concerned within a period two days from today.

In view thereof, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.4 to proceed in accordance with law upon consideration of the MLR as well as the complaint/representation (Annexure P-2) submitted by the petitioner, within a period of 02 weeks from today.
