The prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.PC is for the grant of anticipatory bail in case registered vide FIR No.71 dated 02.04.2022 under Sections 452, 458, 323, 324, 325, 326, 506, 148 and 149 IPC registered at P.S. Jamalpur, District Ludhiana.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 02.05.2023 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 02.05.2023 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 02.05.2023 is made absolute.
