1. The petitioner, through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is seeking direction to the respondents to re-issue her passport with correct date of birth.

2. The petitioner was issued passport on 10.11.2008 which was valid up to 09.11.2018. In the passport, the date of birth of the petitioner has been recorded as 25.04.1973. As per the petitioner, her correct date of birth is 20.03.1975. The petitioner filed online application dated 24.08.2022 before the respondents seeking re-issuance of her passport with correct date of birth. The application is still pending. The petitioner is having documentary evidence of correct date of birth.

3. Ms. Shweta Nahata, learned counsel for the respondents submits that petitioner may be directed to appear before respondent

requisite documents. If the petitioner appears on the aforesaid date along with the all requisite documents, the passport authority would pass an appropriate order within 6 weeks in accordance with law.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner agrees to the said arrangement.

5. In the wake of statements of learned counsels for the parties, the present petition stands disposed of.
