1. The prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of impugned order dated 27.04.2023 (Annexure P-9) passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Abohar, District Fazilka whereby non-bailable warrant has been issued against the petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner at the outset submits that the petitioner is willing and ready to appear, and surrender before the Appellate Court and deposit 20% of the compensation amount as directed by the lower Appellate Court. Hence, in the aforementioned facts and circumstances, the petitioner be protected till his appearance before the lower Appellate Court with directions to the Court below that his bail application, which he would be filing on his surrender, be decided expeditiously.

3. In view of the limited prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of with directions to the petitioner to appear and surrender before the lower Appellate Court within seven days from today and deposit 20% of compensation amount as directed by the Court below. Till then, no coercive steps be taken against the petitioner. Upon moving an application for bail/suspension of sentence, same shall be decided to the Court below expeditiously in accordance with law.

4. It is made clear that in case, the petitioner fails to surrender before the lower Appellate Court and deposit the compensation amount within 07 days from today, this order shall be of no avail to him.
