VIKAS BAHL, J. (ORAL)

1. This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ, order or direction especially in the nature of certiorari for quashing the impugned order dated 18.04.2023 (Annexure P-12) passed by respondent No.3, whereby, the allotment of the shop of the petitioner has been cancelled.

2. Learned State Counsel has submitted that in the present case, the Managing Committee of Mandir of Shree Kali Devi Ji has instituted a petition under Section 4 of the Punjab Religious Premises and Land (Eviction and Rent Recovery) Act, 1997 and thus, the procedure as per law is being followed for the eviction of the present petitioner. It is further

submitted that till the time, an order is not passed by the authority under the said Act, the petitioner would not be evicted.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the statement made by learned State Counsel satisfies the claim of the petitioner and further prays that the petitioner be permitted to raise all the pleas in the said proceedings.

4. Keeping in view the abovesaid facts and circumstances, the present Civil Writ Petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

5. The State would be bound by the abovesaid statement.

6. All the concerned parties would be permitted to raise all the pleas which have been raised in the present writ petition and as are available to them in law in the said proceedings.

7. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand disposed of in view of the abovesaid order.
