VIKAS BAHL, J. (ORAL)

This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent Nos.2 and 3 to make the necessary correction/alteration against the name of mother of the petitioner in Matriculation Certificate dated 22.05.2017 (Annexure P-4).

On 06.01.2023, the following order was passed by this Court:-

“Learned counsel for respondent Nos.2 and 3 has submitted that primary objection which has been raised by respondent Nos.2 and 3 in correcting the name of the mother of the petitioner as per the school record is that the application has not been moved through proper channel inasmuch as as

per the applicable Rules, a student who has passed an examination as a private candidate, as is the case of the present petitioner, would be required to send an application through Principal/Head of the last attended School and would also be required to pay fees.

Learned counsel for the petitioner as well as respondent No.4-School have submitted that representation dated 17.06.2019 (Annexure P-6) was submitted by the School in which it was stated that name of mother of the petitioner is Reena Rani and the name is required to be changed from Reena Devi to Reena Rani which is as per the school register. It is further submitted that specific averment regarding giving of the said representation has been made in para 9 of the petition which has not been denied in para 9 of the written statement.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is ready to pay any fee that may be required for the said purpose.

Keeping in view the abovesaid facts and circumstances, learned counsel for respondent Nos.2 and 3 is directed to get instructions in the matter.

Adjourned to 24.01.2023.

The petitioner is also directed to get in touch with respondent No.3 in order to comply with any formality that needs to be fulfilled.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that although, the uncle of the petitioner had personally gone on 20.01.2023 but however, the needful was not done.

Learned counsel for respondent Nos.2 and 3 has submitted that correction/alteration in the Matriculation Certificate as prayed for by the

petitioner would be carried out within a period of four weeks from today. It is further submitted that the petitioner, after a period of four weeks can come and collect the said certificate and the same would be handed over to her after she pays the necessary fees.

Keeping in view the abovesaid facts and circumstances, the present Civil Writ Petition is disposed of with direction to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to carry out the necessary corrections in the Matriculation Certificate dated 22.05.2017 (Annexure P-4) within a period of four weeks from today and to hand over the same to the petitioner on her depositing the necessary fees.
