1. This is a civil writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the impugned final result dated 28.02.2019 (Annexure P-8) and individual result of the petitioner (Annexure P-10) with a further prayer to award 4 more marks to the petitioner for higher educational qualification.

2. Learned State counsel has submitted that as per letter dated 20.01.2023 issued by the Secretary, Haryana Staff Selection Commission to the Director General of Police, the petitioner is entitled to 4 marks of graduation and on account of the same, his marks have been increased to 47.20 marks in ESM-Gen category and his overall performance under the criteria falls in the selection zone and is selected at Merit no.5010-A for the post of Male Constable (GD) against Advt. no.3/2018 and thus,

recommendation has been made in his favour subject to medical examination and other aspects. It is stated that in view of the same, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

3. The letter dated 20.01.2023 issued by the Secretary, Haryana Staff Selection Commission to the Director General of Police, is taken on record as Mark A.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in view of the above said decision, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and the same be disposed of.

5. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
