The petitioner has filed the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India with a prayer to direct the respondents No.2 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and to restrain the respondents No.5 to 7 from unnecessarily harassing the petitioner and her family members.

A short reply by way of an affidavit of Inspector General of Police, Ludhiana Range, District Ludhiana was filed on behalf of respondents No.1,2,4 and 6.

Learned State counsel contends that the petitioner had submitted various complaints/applications to different police officials. The preliminary enquiry in the aforementioned complaints submitted by both the sides have been transferred from the Police District Khanna to Police District SBS Nagar vide the letter No.11480/A-5 dated 15.05.2023 issued by the Inspector General of Police, Ludhiana.

He further contends that the preliminary enquiry in the said applications is presently being conducted by S.P (Detective) SBS Nagar and copy of said letter has been annexed herewith as Annexure R1/1.

In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, learned counsel for the petitioner does not want to press the instant petition.

Dismissed as not pressed.
