1. Prayer in the present criminal revision petition is for setting aside the impugned order dated 18.04.2022 passed by the Additional Principal Judge, Family Court, Panipat whereby the interim maintenance was declined to the petitioner and only litigation expenses to the tune of Rs.10,000/- was granted to her for pursuing petition under Section 125 Cr.P.C.

2. Today there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

3. As per the paper book the marriage between the parties was solemnized on 11.03.2015. The petitioner filed a petition under Section 125 Cr.P.C alleging that respondent is B.Tech qualified and earning Rs.40,000/- per month. His father is owner of 28 acres of agricultural land situated in District Panipat whereas petitioner is having no source of income to maintain herself. The application was contested by the respondent-husband and alleging that he is earning Rs.12,500/- per month. It was also alleged that petitioner is also working and earning a salary of Rs.30,000/- per month. She is also B.Tect qualified. Family Court observed that both the parties are highly educated. The petitioner herself is B.Tech qualified, as such it cannot be held that she is having no means to

earn and support herself. Consequently, the application for grant of interim maintenance was dismissed.

4. There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner and the impugned order dated 18.04.2022 passed by the Additional Principal Judge, Family Court, Panipat is well reasoned. As such, no ground is made out for intereference, consequently the present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.
