JASJIT SINGH BEDI, J. (ORAL)

The prayer in the present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for the grant of regular bail in case bearing FIR No.242 dated 30.10.2022 (Annexure P-1) registered under Section 323, 341, 506, 34 IPC and Sections 325, 308 IPC added later on at Police Station Shahkot, District Jalandhar.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner at the very outset contends that a compromise has been effected between the parties as is borne out from (Annexure P-3). He contends that the petitioner has been in custody since 03.02.2023 and the investigation stands completed. Therefore, the further incarceration of the petitioner was not required.

3. On the other hand, the learned State counsel admits the factum of a compromise as has been effected between the parties but contends that

the seriousness of the allegations did not entitle the petitioner to the grant of bail.

4. The learned counsel for the complainant has accepted the factum of compromise and has stated that he has no objection if the petitioner is granted the concession of bail.

5. I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

6. Admittedly, the petitioner is in custody since 03.02.2023. A compromise has been arrived at between the parties as is borne out from (Annexure P-3). The investigation stands completed. At this stage, his further incarceration in the present case is not required.

7. Thus without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner-Angrej Singh son of Pakhar Singh is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned CJM/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

8. The petition stands disposed of.
