Power of attorney on behalf of respondent No.4 has been filed by
Mr. Sarbjit Singh, Advocate, which is taken on record.

Status report by way of an affidavit of Shri Sanjeev Kumar, PPS,
Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Ajnala, Amritsar Rural has been
filed on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3. Para No.13 of the said status report
reads as under:

*“That it is respectfully submitted that in view of the above submissions, it
transpires that all the contentions being raised in this paragraph by the
petitioners are devoid of any valid grounds and merits, which are liable to
be rejected out rightly. The petitioners have not been caused any kind of
harassment by the local police or respondent no. 4. The petitioners have
never been restrained by the local police or respondent No. 4-Amarjit
Singh from harvesting wheat crops from their fields, which they almost
have already harvested. The petitioners have not given any representation
(Annexure P/2) in the office of the Senior Superintendent of Police,
Amritsar Rural. The petitioners have filed the present petition with a
malafide intention to create undue pressure upon the local police in order*

to impede investigation of the aforesaid FIR No. 118/2022 (supra) and to create obstructions in the efforts being made for effecting arrest of the aforesaid absconding persons. The investigation of the aforesaid case FIR no. 118/2022 (supra) is being conducted in a fair and impartial manner and would be taken to its logical conclusion. Therefore, the present petition is liable to be dismissed.”

There is no representation on behalf of the petitioners.

Having regard to the stand taken by respondent Nos.1 to 3 in the status report filed today, as reproduced above and considering the fact that there is no representation on behalf of the petitioners, this petition has become infructuous.

Disposed of, having become infructuous.
