The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.31 dated 14.03.2023 registered under Sections 21 of Mines and Minerals (Regulation of Development) Act, 1957 and Section 379 IPC at Police Station Meharban, District Ludhiana.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 04.05.2023, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

A reply dated 14.07.2023 by way of an affidavit Gurdev Singh, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police (East), Ludhiana has been filed on behalf of the State by the learned counsel for the State. The same is taken on record. He on instructions admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 04.05.2023 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on

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joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
