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SUVIR SEHGAL, J. (Oral)

1. Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking quashing of FIR No.49 dated 17.12.2021, registered for offences under Sections 196, 200, 420, 468 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Sections 467 and 471, IPC were added later on), at Police Station NRI, Ludhiana, District Ludhiana, Annexure P-1, along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of the compromise dated 16.05.2022, Annexure P-2, arrived at between the parties.
2. Upon instructions, counsel representing respondent No.2 has made a categoric statement that although a settlement was arrived at between the parties, but it no longer exists. He submits that the complainant has initiated legal proceedings against the accused.
3. Counsel for the petitioners is not in a position to refute the statement.
4. In view of the above, petition is dismissed.
