The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C praying for quashing of FIR No.167 dated 14.4.2022 registered under sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 364 IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act at Police Station, Model Town, Panipat and for quashing of challan/final report under section 173 Cr.P.C dated 14.10.2022, order framing charge dated 30.1.2023 passed by learned Addl. Sessions Judge, Panipat along with all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

Learned counsel for the petitioners fairly submits that the dispute is matrimonial in nature and there are other litigations pending between the parties. He does not press the present petition and prays for withdrawal of the same, at this stage. However, he submits that as the petitioners are respected persons of the society and are facing the protracted trial since long and keeping in view the same Trial Court may be directed to expedite the trial and conclude the same expeditiously.

Notice of motion to respondent no.1, at this stage.

On the asking of the court, Mr. Sandeep Kumar, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent no.1-State.

In view of the above position, present petition is dismissed as withdrawn, at this stage. Learned Trial Court is requested to conclude the trial expeditiously and preferably within a period of 8 months from today.
