The prayer in the present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for the grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.06 dated 19.01.2023 under Sections 307, 324, 341, 427, 506, 148 and 149 IPC registered at Police station City, Kotkapura, District Faridkot (Section 326 IPC added later on vide DDR No.48 dated 15.03.2023 at Police Station City Kotkapura, District Faridkot.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that a compromise has been effected between the parties. As the petitioner was in custody since 27.01.2023, the investigation stands completed and none of prosecution witnesses had been examined so far, his further incarceration was not required.

3. The learned counsel for the complainant admits the fact that a compromise has been effected between the parties, pursuant to which, a petition bearing CRM-M-19372-2023 seeking quashing of FIR No. 06 dated

19.01.2023 has been filed. He states that he has no objection if the petitioner is granted the concession of bail.

4. The learned counsel for the State admits the factum of a compromise having been effected between the parties as also the filing of a petition for quashing of the FIR in question.

5. I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

6. Admittedly, a compromise has been effected between the parties, pursuant to which, a petitioner bearing CRM-M-19372-2023 has been filed for quashing of the FIR No.06 dated 19.01.2023. In this view of the matter, the further incarceration of the petitioner is not required.

7. Thus, without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner, namely, Khushpreet Singh alias Golu is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
