PANKAJ JAIN, J. (Oral)

Counsel for respondent No.2 submits that the present writ petition which is directed against interim order passed by the Tribunal related to the termination of the respondent No.2 has been rendered infructuous as respondent No.2 has already tendered her resignation. However, it has been submitted that her relieving order and the experience certificate has not been issued till date.

2. Ms. Raj does not dispute the fact that respondent No.2 has already tendered resignation and the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous. However, she feigns ignorance w.r.t. prayer made by counsel representing respondent No.2 today in the Court.

3. Be that as it may, petitioner No.2 is directed to release the relieving order and the experience certificate of respondent No.2 in accordance with law within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

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4. Consequently, the present writ petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
5. Needless to say that the aforesaid direction does not absolve respondent No.2, if any dues are pending.
6. Ordered accordingly.
