LISA GILL, J.

This appeal has been filed by the appellant-husband challenging judgment and decree dated 08.02.2019, whereby his petition under Section 13 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, has been dismissed by the learned Family Court, Hisar.

The applicant-appellant was directed to remain present before the Court (through virtual mode) vide order dated 05.10.2021. The appellant did not appear and the matter was adjourned at request of learned counsel for the applicant-appellant, who on 12.11.2021 stated that he did not have instructions to appear on behalf of the appellant. Notice was issued to the appellant in this situation.

As per office report, notice issued to the appellant has been received back unserved on both the available addresses with the report that no such person is residing at the said addresses.

Mr. Amitabh Tewari, Advocate reiterates and pleads no instructions.

In this view of the matter, we are left with no option but to dismiss this appeal for non-prosecution.
