The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to respondent no.2 to conduct proper investigation on the complaint filed by the petitioner, regarding committing of fraud of Rs.9,24,000/- alleged to have been done by the private respondent nos. 4 to 6.

A perusal of the record shows that on 06.09.2022, learned counsel for the petitioner had sought time for supplying correct / complete address of respondent nos.4 to 6 within a period of four weeks and on doing so notice were to be issued to the said respondents, however, the same was not furnished and again on 13.12.2022, learned counsel for petitioner sought adjournment for the same purpose. However, the correct / complete address of said respondents has not been furnished by the counsel for the petitioner till date.

No one has caused appearance on behalf of the petitioner today. The case pertains to the year, 2018. It seems that the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the present petition and otherwise also, the petitioner has an alternative remedy under Section 156 (3) Cr.P.C. to approach the competent court of law for redressal of his grievance.

Dismissed for non-prosecution.
