1. The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of Cross case DDR No.0019 dated 07.06.2017 under Sections 323, 341, 506 and 34 of IPC (Section 325 IPC added later on) (Annexure P-1) in FIR No.0045 dated 06.06.2017, registered at Police Station Singh Bhagwantput, Tehsil and District Rupnagar (Annexure P-2) alongwith all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 13.03.2023 (Annexure P-4).

2. Vide order dated 09.05.2023, a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Magistrate for getting their statements recorded with respect to the compromise.

3. Pursuant to aforesaid order, the parties have appeared before the Civil Judge (Junior Division)-cum-JMIC, Rupnagar and got their statements

recorded. Report dated 25.08.2023 has been received whereby after recording the statements of the parties, the Court below has shown its that the compromise is genuine, voluntary and without any coercion or undue influence.

4. I have heard counsel for the parties and gone through the case file.

5. In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court below and considering the offence for which the accused have been charged are not of serious nature, together with the fact that compromise will go a long way in ironing out the differences for betterment of future life of the parties and also in view of the law laid down in **Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another, 2012 (4) RCR (Criminal) 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab 2007(3) RCR (Criminal) 1052**, the present petition for quashing the FIR is allowed qua the petitioners.

6. Resultantly, DDR No.0019 dated 07.06.2017 under Sections 323, 341, 506 and 34 of IPC (Section 325 IPC added later on) (Annexure P-1) in FIR No.0045 dated 06.06.2017, registered at Police Station Singh Bhagwantput, Tehsil and District Rupnagar (Annexure P-2) alongwith all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 13.03.2023 (Annexure P-4) are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
