This petition has been filed seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to promote the petitioner as regular Principal w.e.f. 28.12.2017 with all consequential benefits. Another prayer in this petition is to direct the respondents to re-employ the petitioner on the post of Principal beyond retirement as per policy w.e.f. 06.05.2022 (Annexure P-7) from the date his juniors were re-employed, with all consequential benefits.

2. Learned State counsel, by referring to a communication dated 19.07.2023 from respondent No.2, has stated that by counting the petitioner's adhoc service to his seniority, he has already been granted deemed date of promotion to the post of Principal with effect from the date his immediate junior was so promoted, i.e., from 28.04.2011, vide order dated 07.09.2022 (Annexure A-1). So far as the second prayer in the petition is concerned, it has been submitted that this Court, vide order dated 27.05.2022, passed in CWP No.11755 of 2022 titled *Satyapal Singh and others v. State of Haryana and others*, has stayed re-employment of retired

Principals. Therefore, the petitioner cannot be considered for re-employment.

3. In view thereof, the petition has been rendered infructuous, and disposed of as such.
