All these petitions are being disposed off by common order as they have arisen out of the same FIR with identical facts.

2. The jurisdiction of this Court under Section 439 Cr.P.C., has been invoked for the grant of regular bail to the petitioner(s) in FIR No. 205, dated 03.12.2020, under Sections 302 and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Shimlapuri, Ludhiana.

3. A perusal of the case file shows that vide order dated 24.02.2022, the petitioners were admitted to interim bail on furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court, till the next date of hearing. The said interim order is being extended from time to time, on the request of respondent-State alone wherein, the investigation was underway with the Bureau of Investigation, which stands now completed and thereafter the State has constituted a SIT, who is seeking time for conducting NARCO test upon the petitioners.

4. Today, again a similar request has been made by the counsel for the State though taking a specific stand, on instructions, that now time slot 03.07.2022 to 15.07.2023 has been given for conducting the NARCO test upon the petitioners.

5. As has been observed hereinabove, all the petitioners are already on interim bail since 24.02.2022 and the said relief is continuing, it is not the stand of the respondent-State including the Bureau of Investigation that none of the petitioners have so far misuse the concession of said relief.

6. In the light of above, the order dated 24.02.2022 granting interim relief to the petitioners, is hereby, made absolute and the petitioners are directed to furnish fresh bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial

Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

- 7. In view of above, the present petition is disposed off.
- 8. A copy of this order be placed on the files of the other connected petitions.
