The prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of FIR No.102 dated 13.04.2018 under Sections 447, 506, 511 IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Ludhiana, District Ludhiana as well as other consequential proceedings arising out the aforesaid FIR.

The learned counsel for the petitioners at the very outset submits that since the charges have been framed and the case is posted for prosecution evidence, he does not wish to press the present petition. He, however, prays that since the petitioner No.1 is of the age of 76 years and petitioner No.2 is of the age of 71 years, their personal appearance before the Trial Court be exempted.

In view of the above, the present petition is ordered to be disposed of as not pressed. However, keeping in view the age of the petitioners, the prayer of the learned counsel for the petitioners seems to be genuine. In case, the petitioners No.1 and 2 move an appropriate application before the Trial Court, it shall consider the request of the petitioners No.1 and 2 sympathetically keeping in view their respective ages.
