By way of present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for issuance of directions to official respondent Nos. 2 & 3 to look into the grievance of the petitioner, who is being harassed by private respondent Nos. 4 to 6.

[2] Notice of motion stood issued to respondent-State only vide order dated 27.05.2022 passed by this Court.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner has pointed out that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his client would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No. 2-Director General of Police, Punjab Police Headquarter, Chandigarh, to look into the matter and pass a speaking order thereon expeditiously, while treating the present petition as representation on behalf of petitioner.

[4] Learned State Counsel raises no objection against the innocuous

prayer made on behalf of the petitioner.

[5] In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without going into the merits of the controversy, this petition is **disposed off** with a direction to respondent No. 2-Director General of Police, Punjab Police Headquarter, Chandigarh, to look into the grievance of petitioner by treating the present petition as representation and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably within a period of six (06) weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
