ANOOP CHITKARA J. (ORAL)

The present petition has been filed seeking quashing of impugned order dated 01.06.2021 vide which the order of anticipatory bail granted to the petitioner is cancelled.

On 06.01.2023, this Court had passed the following order:-

“On joint request of counsel for the parties, date of hearing in the main case is preponed from 13.01.2023 to today itself i.e. 06.01.2023 and the main case is taken up on board.

After arguing for some time, counsel for the petitioner on instructions submits that they are ready to redeem the mortgaged land and ready to handover the redemption deed to the original owner subject to the condition that it shall be without all just exceptions and without any prejudice to his right in the RSA pending before this Court.

Prayer being innocuous is accepted, as such, let the petitioner redeem the mortgaged land and handover redemption deed to the original owner before the next date positively.

It is clarified that in case, if the petitioner fails to comply with the above said undertaking before the next date, on this ground alone, the main petition shall be dismissed.

List the main matters on 01.02.2023.

In the meantime, no coercive steps shall be taken against the petitioner.

CRM-294-2023 stands disposed of accordingly. ”

Given above, counsel for the petitioner submits that bail granted by the trial Court may be restored and he would have no objection in case this Court imposes stringent conditions.

Counsel for the petitioner on instructions submits that the order has been complied with. The reasons for which bail was cancelled are no more there.

Given above, the present petition is allowed and impugned order dated 01.06.2021, is set aside subject to the conditions that Within twenty days from today, the petitioner shall forward to the Investigator/SHO and the complainant/victim(s) the complete details of bank account numbers with addresses, fixed deposits, DEMAT account numbers, the current market value of jewelry, sovereign metals, all precious articles, held either individually or jointly, and cash-in-hand. *If the petitioner fail to comply with this condition, then on this ground alone. In that case, the bail might be canceled, and the complainant may file any such application for the cancellation of bail, and State shall file the said application.*
