The petitioner through instant petition is seeking quashing of impugned order dated 24.11.2015 whereby the Ld. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Moga has rejected the prayer of the petitioner for getting recorded her statement under Section 164 Cr.P.C. Petitioner is further seeking for issuance of direction to Ld. Magistrate to record her statement under Section 164 Cr.P.C.

On 05.04.2022, following order was passed by this Court:

“The petitioner has assailed the order dated 24.11.2015 vide which the application under Section 164 Cr.P.C. was dismissed. The order dated November 27, 2017 indicates that learned State counsel had informed that final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. was presented on 26.07.2016 and the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

However, an adjournment was sought on the ground that arguing counsel was in personal difficulty.

As none has appeared on behalf of the petitioner today, despite passover, in the interest of justice, adjourned to 02.08.2022.”

Even today, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

In view of the afore-stated facts, it appears that the petitioner has lost his interest to pursue the matter.

Dismissed for non-prosecution.
