The petitioner herein prays for the issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari to quash the order (Annexure P-5) passed on 13.04.2023. At the time of the preliminary hearing, the learned State counsel has entered appearance.

Learned counsel representing the petitioner, inter alia, contends that no reason whatsoever has been recorded by the competent authority while rejecting the petitioner's request for forwarding his name for the post of the Punjab Civil Services, Executive Branch, Class I Service, under the category of the handicapped persons. Learned State counsel submits that the competent authority will pass a fresh speaking order within two weeks, after granting an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner.

In view of the aforesaid facts, no further order is required to be passed.
