This is a petition filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India praying for setting aside the order dated 28.09.2017 (Annexure P-9) passed by the Civil Judge (Senior Division), Amritsar, whereby the application for restoration of the contempt petition has been dismissed, as well as, the orders dated 12.10.2022 (Annexures P-13 and P-14) passed by the Additional District Judge, Amritsar, whereby the appeal and the application under Order 41 Rule 27 CPC have been dismissed.
