The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of *Certiorari* for setting aside reply dated 27.03.2019 (Annexure P-8) denying the claim of allotment of paddy to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has already died and he has no instructions from the LRs to appear in the present case.

However, at this stage, Ms. Lavanya Paul, learned DAG, Punjab has submitted on instructions that even otherwise also nothing survives in the present petition and the nature of relief claimed now is only academic in nature. She submitted that the prayer of the petitioner was for

allotment of paddy for the crop year of 2019-2020 and the crop year is already over and therefore, nothing survives in the present petition.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed.
