1. The petitioner is seeking quashing of order dated 09.03.2022 (Annexure P-3) passed by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Hoshiarpur vide which his bail/surety bonds were cancelled and non-bailable warrants were issued against him and order dated 15.03.2023 (Annexure P-6) vide which he was declared a proclaimed person, in complaint case No.NACT/32/2017 titled as 'M/s Himachal Trading Company Vs. Abhishek Bansal' under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner at the outset submits that the petitioner is willing and ready to appear, and surrender before the Trial Court. Hence, in the aforementioned facts and circumstances, the petitioner be protected till his appearance before the Trial Court and with directions to the Trial Court that his bail application, which he would be filing on his surrender, be decided expeditiously.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On asking of the Court, Mr. Ramdeep Partap Singh, Sr.

DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

5. At this stage, Mr. Inderpreet Singh Kooner, Advocate has put in an appearance and filed his vakalatnama on behalf of respondent No.2 which is taken on record.

6. In view of the limited prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of with directions to the petitioner to appear and surrender before the Trial Court within 07 days from today. Till then, no coercive steps be taken against the petitioner.

7. It is made clear that in case, the petitioner fails to surrender before the Trial Court within 07 days from today, this order shall be of no avail to him. In case, on appearance and surrender, the petitioner moves an application for bail before the Trial Court, the same shall be decided expeditiously by the Trial Court in accordance with law.
