AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

1. None has appeared on behalf of the petitioner. Similar was the position on the last date.

2. On 4th May, 2023, following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that impugned order dated 23.02.2022 may be quashed as it would facilitate the conclusion of the trial.

Notice of motion.

Mr. H.S. Gharoo, Advocate for Mr. Amit Kumar Goyal, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of Union of India and waives service. The petitioner is directed to surrender before the trial Court on or before 12.05.2023 and seek regular bail. In case, such an application is filed, the same shall be decided expeditiously but not later than seven days from the date of filing of the same.

Adjourned to 24.07.2023.”

3. Learned counsel for the respondent-UOI submits that petitioner surrendered on 19th May, 2023.

4. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for respondent-UOI, no further directions are called for. The petition is disposed of.

5. Needless to say that petitioner would be at liberty to revive the petition if factual discrepancy is found in the statement made by learned counsel for the respondent.
6. Since the main case has been disposed of, pending application if any is rendered infructuous.
