Petitioner has approached this Court with a grievance, as has been highlighted by him in his various representations as submitted by him. Now the petitioner has approached this Court after serving a legal notice dated 17.03.2023 (Annexure P-4), which also has not been responded to nor any action taken for removal of encroachment. Counsel has asserted that the prayer was for removal of encroachment and for decision on the legal notice in the writ petition.

Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 7.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. V.G.Jauhar, Addl. A.G. Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 7.

Without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, we dispose of the present writ petition with directions to the Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Patiala-respondent No. 6 to take

into consideration the legal notice dated 17.03.2023 (Annexure P-4) served by the petitioner and take a decision thereon within a period of eight weeks from today by hearing the parties. Decision, so taken, be conveyed to the petitioner forthwith.

In case the assertions, as made by the petitioner, are found to be correct, the consequential steps, in accordance with law, be initiated within a further period of three weeks.
