- 1. Learned counsel for the petitioners seeks permission to withdraw the present petition.

- 3. Consequently, the extant petition is dismissed as withdrawn but liberty reserved to the petitioners to before the competent Authority concerned, place all the revenue records detailing therein, the existence of a commercial establishment on the petition lands.

Resultantly the said competent Authority shall make a lawful decision on the validity of such documents, and, thereafter shall proceed to pay just and fair compensation in terms of the provisions, as carried in the National Highways Act, 1956.
