JASJIT SINGH BEDI, J.(ORAL)

On 05.05.2023 the following order was passed:-

“ The prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.PC is for quashing of the order dated 21.04.2023 (Annexure P-3) passed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Amritsar whereby the bail orders dated 20.05.2022 and 30.05.2022 have been cancelled and bail bonds/surety bonds of the petitioners were forfeited in FIR No.45 dated 30.03.2022 under Section 379-B IPC registered at Police Station Sultanwind at Amritsar.

The learned counsel for the petitioners contends that on account of noting down of a wrong date, the petitioners were unable to appear on one date i.e. 21.04.2023 on which date the impugned order came to be passed. He states that the petitioners are ready and willing to join the proceedings once again.

In the meanwhile, the petitioners are directed to surrender before the Trial Court within a period of one week from today and subject to a deposit of Rs25,000/- each as costs with the Institute for the Blind, Sector 26, Chandigarh, they shall be admitted to interim bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.”

The Counsel for the petitioner states that in deference to the aforesaid order the petitioners have surrendered themselves before the Trial Court and have since been released on interim bail.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court.

Disposed of.

However, it is expected that the petitioners shall continue to appear before the Trial Court and not absent themselves from the proceedings without sufficient cause.
