By way of filing the present petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C., the petitioner has approached this Court for issuance of directions to the official respondent nos.1 to 3 to conduct fair and impartial investigation and take appropriate action as per law in FIR No. 0183 dated 01.12.2022, under Section 21 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Zira, District Ferozepur (Annexure P-1) and to consider the complaint representation dated 22.03.2023 (Annexure P-3) alleged to have been submitted by the petitioner and to decide the same in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Adhiraj Singh, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that let this petition be disposed of only with a direction to respondent No.3 – Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur to consider and decide the representation dated 20.03.2023 (Annexure P-3) alleged to have been submitted by the petitioner.

Accordingly, without commenting upon the merits of the claim of the petitioner and even the assertions set out in the petition, the present petition is disposed of only with a direction to respondent No.3 that if any such representation, as indicated above, is indeed pending consideration, it shall be dealt with expeditiously in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably within six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and convey the same to the petitioner.

The present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
