Counsel contends that the petitioner has been approaching the respondents and respondent No.6-Sub Divisional Magistrate (East) Exercising powers of Estate Officer, U.T. Chandigarh vide order dated 08.05.2017 (Annexure P-5) has ordered deletion of the show cause notice *qua* the father of the petitioner as the share has not yet been transferred in the name of the petitioner. Counsel, thus, contends that the claim of the petitioner needs to be decided by the respondents but no decision on the notice/representation by the

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counsel dated 12.10.2022 (Annexure P-7), has been taken by the respondents till date.

Mr. Anil Mehta, Senior Standing Counsel for respondents No.2 to 6, who is present in Court, states that the matter is pending adjudication *qua* the said SCF, which would be decided by the competent authority within a period of six weeks which would include the claim as has been put forth by the petitioner also.

In light of the above statement made by learned counsel for the respondents, we dispose of the petition by binding the respondents by the statement as has been made by learned senior standing counsel. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner.
