Petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.PC seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.31 dated 09.02.2022 under Section 379 IPC, 1860 registered at Police Station Sri Muktsar Sahib, District Sri Muktsar Sahib, Punjab (Annexure P-1).

Counsel for the parties are ad idem that in terms of the order dated 27.05.2022 the petitioner has already appeared before the Ld. Trial Court and has been released on interim bail. Learned State counsel further submits that the recovery has also been effected.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 27.05.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute. The learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sukhwinder Singh has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his further investigation in the present case is not required.

In view of the above, interim order dated 27.05.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

The present petition stands disposed off.
