This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the Assistant Collector, Ist Grade-cum-SDM, Barnala not to enter the mutation in the revenue records.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in the present case, the petitioner has filed the revision before the Commissioner, Patiala Division, Patiala against the order dated 16.05.2018 and the said revision petition is of the year 2019 and is now pending for 29.03.2023 for appearance of respondent Nos.1 and 2 who are respondent Nos.6 and 7 in the present writ petition. It is further submitted that the petitioner would

limit his prayer to the direction to the Commissioner to decide the said revision petition as expeditiously as possible. It is further prayed that since, respondent Nos.6 and 7 have not appeared in the revision petition thus they may also be directed to appear before the Commissioner on 29.03.2023.

Learned counsel for the private respondents has submitted that respondent Nos.6 and 7 who are respondent Nos.1 and 2 before the Commissioner would appear before the Commissioner on 29.03.2023.

Learned State Counsel has submitted that every endeavour would be made by the Commissioner to decide the revision petition as expeditiously as possible.

Keeping in view the abovesaid facts and circumstances, the present Civil Writ Petition is disposed of with directions to the Commissioner, Patiala Division, Patiala to decide the revision petition filed by the petitioner within a period of two months from 29.03.2023. Respondent Nos.6 and 7 who are respondent Nos.1 and 2 before the Commissioner are directed to appear before the Commissioner on the next date of hearing which is stated to be 29.03.2023.

Learned counsel appearing before the Commissioner are requested to fully assist the Court in expeditious disposal of the revision petition.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand disposed of in view of the abovesaid order.
