Prayer in this petition is for initiating contempt proceedings for non-compliance of the order dated 30.09.2021 (Annexure P-19) passed in CWP-13107-2021.

As per the affidavit filed by Block Development and Panchayat Officer, Palwal, District Palwal on behalf of respondent No.2, fresh demarcation was done by following a proper procedure and the Gram Panchayat has already filed petition under Section 7 of the Punjab Village Common Land Act, 1961 for ejectment of 25 unauthorized occupants, who were found in illegal possession as per the demarcation report and the same is now pending with the Assistant Collector, First Grade-cum-Sub Divisional Officer (C), Palwal.

In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous.

Rule stands discharged.

However, the petitioner is granted liberty to avail alternative remedy in accordance with law, if so required.
