The petitioner is seeking to quash the FIR No.300 dated 18.12.2017 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Division No. 5, Ludhiana.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Jasbir Singh submits that during the course of investigation, the petitioner has been found to be innocent. Accordingly, the report under Section 173 Cr.P.C has been presented against Baljit Kaur and Gulshan Rai only and the name of the petitioner has been reflected in column no.2. Accordingly, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
