1. Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case having FIR No.94 dated 18.01.2017 registered under Section 174-A IPC at Police Station Sadar, District Gurugram.
2. The counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that the aforesaid FIR was registered on the ground that the petitioner was declared as proclaimed person in criminal case having FIR No.27 dated 19.1.2015 registered under Sections 420, 468, IPC at Police Station Sadar, District Gurugram. The counsel for the petitioner further submits that in the said main case having FIR No.27 dated

19.1.2015, the petitioner has been granted regular bail and he is regularly appearing before the learned trial Court and the copy of the concerned order is placed on record. The counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner is also ready to join investigation/proceedings before the trial Court, in the present case.

3. Notice of motion.
4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Naveen Kumar Sheoran, DAG, accepts notice on behalf of State of Harayana and on instructions from ASI Raju submits that as the petitioner is granted regular bail in main case having FIR No.27 dated 19.1.2015 registered under Sections 420, 468, IPC at Police Station Sadar, District Gurugram he could be directed to join the investigation/proceedings before the trial Court. The State counsel further apprised the Court that the challan has been presented and now proceedings are pending before the learned trial Court.
5. In view of the above, the petitioner is hereby directed to appear before the learned trial Court within next 15 days and on his doing so, the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail by the said Court to its own satisfaction.
6. The present petition is disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
