Affidavit of Shri Naunihal Singh, I.P.S., Commissioner of Police, Amritsar City has been filed on behalf of respondent showing the compliance of order dated 02.03.2023.

Reply is also tagged with Annexure R-1/T as per which petitioner Ashok Kumar duly received the intimation and undertook to appear before this Court along with his counsel for today. However, nobody has made appearance on behalf of the petitioner. There is no reason for adjourning the matter further.

Perusal of the file reveals that petitioner was convicted under Section 420 of the IPC vide judgment dated 18.10.2008 passed by Learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Amritsar in a case arising out of FIR No.327 dated 24.09.2002 registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Amritsar under Sections 420/34 of the IPC. He was sentenced to rigorous imprisonment for a period of one year and also to pay a fine of ₹2,000/-

Appeal filed by the petitioner was dismissed by the First Appellate Court vide judgment dated 12.10.2010.

Against the aforesaid concurrent finding of the Courts below, this revision was filed. The sentence of the appellant was suspended vide order dated 21.02.2011. Now, despite his service, petitioner is not making appearance nor there is any representation for him, which indicate that he is no longer interested in pursuing the petition.

In all the aforesaid circumstances, this revision is hereby dismissed for want of prosecution.

A copy of this order be sent to Learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Amritsar to take the petitioner in custody and send him to jail so as to carry out the sentence.
