The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of FIR No.0031 dated 12.05.2017 registered under Section 498-A IPC at Police Station Women Cell, Sector-17, Chandigarh on the basis of compromise dated 11.01.2022 (Annexure P-2) between the parties.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 submits that a joint petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 was filed, which has been allowed by Additional District Judge, Chandigarh on 17.02.2023.
