1. Through the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks quashing of order dated 17.03.2023 passed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Amritsar (for short – the Appellate Court) directing the petitioner to deposit 20% amount of compensation imposed by the trial court through its order dated 21.02.2023.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that because the petitioner and the respondent/complainant have settled their dispute, he be permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioner to move an appropriate application before the Appellate Court seeking therein to compound his conviction under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 and for seeking waiver of the conditions imposed through the impugned order as also for bail.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that his client is also ready to deposit the requisite costs with the District Legal Services

Authority at Amritsar in terms of the guidelines by the Supreme Court in
