The petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.105 dated 18.04.2015, registered at Police Station, Badhra, District Bhiwani, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 & 120-B IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 (later on Section 420, 467, 468, 471 & 120-B IPC has been deleted and the investigation is carried out only for offence under Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was arrested in an FIR registered on account of being declared a proclaimed person. He has been granted regular bail in the said case. The only allegation against the petitioner in this case is that he has procured a fake arms license from Nagaland. Thus, the petitioner may be granted bail.

Admittedly, the petitioner is a proclaimed person and thus, he does not deserve the concession of anticipatory bail.

The petition is, accordingly, dismissed.
