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**DEEPAK GUPTA, J. (ORAL)**

The petitioner is seeking regular bail by way of this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.48 dated 06.02.2022 registered under Sections 457 & 380 of the IPC registered at Police Station Uklana, District Hisar.

As per the prosecution allegations, some unknown persons had stolen 24 carats gold weighing 5 tola, one pair of gold earrings, 5 tola of silver anklets and ₹1,03,000/- on the intervening night of 05/06.02.2022 from the house of complainant Naveen Kumar.

It is alleged that during investigation petitioner was arrested on 25.02.2022 and on the basis of disclosure statement suffered by him, one pair of gold earring, some gold, cash amount of ₹10,000/- and iron rod were recovered. Besides, motorcycle used in the incident was also recovered from him.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is in custody for the last 1 year 3 months and 10 days. Trial may take long time to conclude and case is exclusively triable by Magistrate.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Randhir Singh, Addl. AG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.

Learned State counsel has drawn attention towards the contents of the petition itself in which it is mentioned that petitioner is involved in 7 more cases of similar nature and thus he is a habitual offender.

Considering the fact that petitioner is in custody for the last 1 year 3 months and 10 days; trial may take long time to conclude and the case is exclusively triable by Magistrate but without commenting anything on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and petitioner is admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Learned Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned, on usual terms and conditions.
