1. Instant petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.PC. seeking regular bail in case FIR No.57 dated 20.04.2022 under Sections 307, 323, 148, 149 of IPC, 1860, registered at Police Station Nihal Singh Wala, District Moga (Annexure P-1).
2. Upon instructions, State counsel submits that petition has become infructuous as the petitioner has been acquitted by the trial Court vide judgment dated 12.07.2023. He has placed on record a copy of the judgment.
